SPEAKER NICHOL: Is there any more discussion on the bill? I am sorry, Senator Chronister, I didn't hear what you said. The question is, shall the bill advance. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, a request for a record vote. (Record vote read. See page 1327, Legislative Journal.) 28 ayes, 4 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill advances. Senator Haberman, are you ready to go on LB 533. Mr. Clerk, do you have anything?

SENATOR HABERMAN: If I am not ready now, I never am. Mr. President, we will take it up.

SPEAKER NICHOL: What did you say?

SENATOR HABERMAN: Yes.

SPEAKER NICHOL: I understand that.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 533 (read title). The bill was first read on January 19th, Mr. President. It was referred to the Education Committee for hearing. The bill was indefinitely postponed by the Education Committee. Pursuant to a motion to raise the bill by Senator Haberman and DeCamp, the bill was raised. I have a series of amendments pending, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Haberman, would you like to explain the bill briefly to us and then we will go with the amendments. Please.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. President, the bill extends the deadline dates for which we can contract to build a veterinarian school. The bill authorizes our matching the federal government's funds of \$827,000 and the bill just goes ahead and extends everything that has been done for another year. Basically that is what it does, Mr. President. Do you say there are some amendments, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes. Senator Vickers, did you wish to speak to the bill? Is Senator Warner around? Excuse me, Senator Haberman, I didn't realize you were (interruption).
