CLERK: (Read LB 78 on Final Reading as found on page 1336 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1336 of the Legislative Journal.) 41 ayes, 0 nays, 7 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 78 passes. Senator Schmit has advised that he is working on a possible amendment on 252 at the moment and will let us know in a few minutes whether or not he expects to return the bill for a specific amendment but until such time as he returns to the floor we will go on with LB 270.
