So the only priority bills left are the Speaker's priority bills and those of course are at the discretion of the Speaker anyway so if the Speaker wants to switch those around with appropriation bills and any other bills in the process, it would certainly be his prerogative to do that. The second problem that we had, Senator Chambers in particular of course mentioned the notice problem. The Speaker has assured us that when bills like this come up in the future that we will get some notice of it so I think that solves that problem. In short, I guess what we are saying, I can't speak for anybody but myself really, but I feel that an understanding has been reached, that this action is not a precedent but is a reaction to an emergency situation and will be considered as such and that for my part I am willing to go ahead and proceed and deal with these and try to establish in the future some relationship between these kinds of bills and priority bills that makes sense for the body in the future. Thank you.
