LB 263A, 266A

SENATOR GOODRICH: Mr. President, members of the body, this is a little unusual but I am asking, in fact I am making a motion to indefinitely postpone LB 263A, the reason being that the bill just isn't needed. If we do this we will wind up giving them money they don't need in the department.
