LB 259A, 503A, 134

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the A bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is advanced. LB 269A.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 269 A was offered by Senator Cullan and he has yet to arrive.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hoagland, did you wish to handle that or Senator Beutler? It is the A bill for the judges salaries.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, I would suggest that we pass that bill over this morning and take it up at some future date.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, we will pass over 269A. LB 503A.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 503A (read title).

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner, were you prepared to handle this? Senator Schmit isn't here. 503A.

SENATOR WARNER: Yes, Mr. President, I will move it be advanced.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Schmit, did you wish to speak to that, 503A? Any other discussion on 503A? All those in favor vote aye, of this advancement, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays to advance the A bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 503A advances. That concludes Section 8 of the file. We will move back up now to Section 6. Senator Pappas, are you more comfortable now? All right, Mr. Clerk, on LB 134.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Pappas would move that LB 134 become law notwithstanding the objection of the Governor.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Pappas.

SENATOR PAPPAS: We couldn't by chance pass this just on a voice vote, could we?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Well, you might try it.
