SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Okay, thank you very much, Senator Warner.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on the committee amendments to 410? If not, the question is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 410. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. We are voting on the adoption of committee amendments to LB 410. May we have the recording of your vote please. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Warner, move to advance the bill.

SENATOR WARNER: Okay, Mr. President, I would move to advance the bill. I should point out if I didn't make it clear, the process for the entering into the contracts are separate obviously for the University and the State Colleges. The bill or the amendments, rather, or the bill now contains the necessary language to do that. I think it is also probable though that when those contracts are entered into which will result in bonds being issued, it will be done together because the odds of getting a better contract terms are much more likely if they do work together and do the total amount at one time, although they will be separate entities cooperating in entering into the contracts.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on LB 410? If not, the motion is to advance that bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the motion to advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries and the bill is advanced. LB 629.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 629 (read title). The bill was first read on March 25th, referred directly to General File. I do have an amendment pending from Senator Warner, Mr. President, The amendment is on page 1297 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner, to take up the amendment.
