CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 1410 and 1411, Legislative Journal.) 23 ayes, 13 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The attempted amendment fails. Do you have anything on your desk, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, I do. Mr. President, the Enrolling Clerk has presented to the Governor that bills that were read on Final Reading this morning.

Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review reports 194 as correctly engrossed, 209 correctly engrossed, 353, 397, 400, 415, 424, 440, 461, 469, 511, 541, 587, 599, all correctly engrossed.

Senator Eret would like to print amendments to LB 617, Mr. President, and that is all that I have.

PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit, do you want to move first to move the bill. The motion is to advance LB 73 from Select File. All those in favor say aye, opposed no...a machine vote has been requested. Machine vote has been requested. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. The motion is the advancement of LB 73. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.
