SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the Beutler amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 2 nays on the adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Beutler amendment has been adopted.

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Haberman, did you wish to speak to the bill?

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. President, I've got a five-page speech here but due to all this talking and the working and everything we've done, I'm not going to give it and I just move that we'd advance 533, as amended. Unless you have a bunch of lights on.

SPEAKER NICHOL: I have no lights on. Is there any further discussion on the bill itself? If not, the question is the advancement of LB 533. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We'll go machine vote. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a request for record vote. Record vote given. (See pages 1459-60 in the Journal). 26 ayes, 7 nays, Mr. President, on motion to advance the bill. (27 ayes, 6 nays recorded in Journal).

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 533 advances. We'll move over to Section 9 on your agenda to Select File, on the back side, and we'll go to LB 319. Mr. Clerk, do you have something to read in?
