SENATOR MARSH: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, LB 412, you will recall is the bill that adjusts the vendor fee for trip permits, trucks coming into the state, so that the vendor fee is paid at the time the trip permit is collected the same way the licenses for hunting permits are done. What the amendment does is clarifies two things in existing law. One thing right at first that such trip permits should be acquired at the first available location whether it be a weigh station or a vendor station so that it would be clear, which it currently is not, and secondly the amendment would permit the state patrol to have authority to enforce the provisions as well as the weigh station people currently have. I move adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR MARSH: Is there further discussion? Seeing no other lights we will vote on the Warner amendment to LB 412. All those in favor signify. . . right vote aye, opposed vote no. Senator Marsh voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Marsh voting yes.

SENATOR MARSH: It takes 25 votes to adopt the amendment. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, on adoption of Senator Warner's amendment.

SENATOR MARSH: The amendment is adopted. We are now ready for the advancement of LB 412. Senator Warner, do you want to move its advancement?

SENATOR WARNER: I so move.

SENATOR MARSH: All those in favor signify by saying aye, opposed. It is advanced. Senator Higgins, we are ready for LB 273.
