SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this is the amendment to reduce what was the appropriation for the Tax Commissioner's salary. Senator Pirsch, you asked some questions on this the other day and in reviewing it we found that the...had been calculated on the retirement as well as for the health insurance on the basis of the previous tax commissioner and this one, because she is not eligible for retirement until she served at least two years, that the total appropriation was overstated and can be reduced by approximately \$4,000 so I'd move adoption of that amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the Warner amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Would you please return to your desks long enough to help Senator Warner out on his little amendment. Thank you. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Warner's amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Warner amendment is adopted. Anything else on it, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner, do you want to move the bill?

SENATOR WARNER: Move the bill be advanced.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the advancement of LB 608. All those in favor say aye, opposed nay. It is advanced. LB 628.
