LB 371, 371A, 326

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Schmit's second amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Schmit amendments are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Schmit, we are now on the bill. Do you wish to speak to that?

SENATOR SCHMIT: I have no further comments on the bill, Mr. President. I would move it be advanced.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any other discussion on the bill? The question is the advancement of LB 371. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Say aye, opposed nay. It is advanced. Senator Schmit, do you want to go on the A bill on it now?

SENATOR SCHMIT: I move that LB 371A be advanced.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any discussion on the A bill? All those in favor say aye, opposed nay. It is advanced. I understand there is some work to be done on LB 503, Senator Schmit, right? And we will move on to LB 326. That also is yours, Senator Schmit.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have E & R amendments first of all to LB 326.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Rod Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker, I move we adopt the E & R amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All those in favor say aye, opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schmit would move to amend the bill. The amendment is on page 1195 of the Journal.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Schmit.

CLERK: 1195, Senator.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, this amendment strikes four words "and date of birth" from the provisions that we previously acted upon. It was a request by the press corps and I move adoption of the amendment.
