SPEAKER NICHOL: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign, LR 56. May I direct your attention please, under the south balcony we have some guests of Senator Vickers and they are six members of the FFA, Vicki Hood is their sponsor, Frances Jorgensen is their instructor. Would you please stand and be recognized by your Legislature. Thank you. LR 61.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 61 offered by Senator Wesely found on page 1501 of the Journal.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, this resolution is to recognize those members of Greek Fraternities and Sororities who have participated in Greek Week activity this week and specifically have supported the "Mastodon Marathon", which is a creation they came up with to try to promote the Morrill Hall project. There are a thousand students that have participated in the week long run around down town Lincoln, morning, noon and night, 24 hours a day for seven days this week. What they are doing is an attempt to raise some money, their goal is \$10,000 towards the Morrill Hall project. They have done a lot and this has been a particularly bad week to be out running around. I helped kick it off last Saturday which was in the middle of a snow storm and have yet to recover fully and I know that many of the other participants in this after the snow storm the last couple of days probably haven't enjoyed it as much as they would in normal spring weather, but they have been out there and they have been running and they have been doing the best they can to help with what they are very concerned about and that is the deterioration of the collection at Morrill Hall. This resolution recognizes that effort and the need to do something with the project.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of LR 61. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We are voting on the Resolution, LR 61, please indicate your preference. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.
