SENATOR HIGGINS: Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes, ma'am.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Isn't this something that any senator has a right to do any time they want? Didn't I have it done to me once? I will withdraw my objection. I just wanted to make the point so that those senators that like to play these little games get that sinking feeling and know how it feels.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator DeCamp, did you wish to speak further?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, for the record, Marge is not talking about me, I hope. She says she is not talking about me. She is not mad at me today.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, the record is clear that Senator Higgins is not mad at Senator DeCamp today. We will pass over the bill. We will go on to 272.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 1629-1630 of the Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 3 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.
