SENATOR WIITALA: That would be fine.

PRESIDENT: It is a matter of correction.

CLERK: I'm sorry.

SENATOR WIITALA: Make the new operative date January 1, 1984.

PRESIDENT: It shows here November 15, 1983. You wanted January 1, 1984.

SENATOR WIITALA: Correct.

PRESIDENT: That correction will be made in the Wiitala amendment. It is a matter of form. Is there further discussion on the Wiitala amendment then? All those in favor of the amendment please vote aye, opposed vote nay. 25 votes required for the adoption of the amendment to LB 433. Please record your vote. We need your vote on the amendment to LB 433. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carried and the amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Nichol, would you move the bill, LB 433.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Mr. President, I move we advance LB 433.

PRESIDENT: The motion is made to advance LB 433 off Select File. You have heard the question. All those in favor say aye, opposed no. The motion carried. The bill is advanced. Anything on the desk, Mr. Clerk, to read in?

CLERK: I have nothing on the desk, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Nichol.
