SENATOR WESELY: Well, I guess we will have to go with a Call of the House then.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Senators will please take their seats... the question is whether we should go under Call. All in favor vote yes, all opposed vote nay. This takes a simple majority. Record, Pat.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 1 nay to go under Call.

SENATOR LABEDZ: The House is under Call. All members return to their seats. Unauthorized staff people should leave the floor. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, Senator Labeledz, I will accept call ins I think would be appropriate.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you.

CLERK: Senator Rod Johnson voting yes. Senator Newell voting yes. Senator Cullan voting yes. Senator Eret voting yes.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Record the vote, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 12 nays. Madam Chair, I have a request for a record vote. (Read the record vote as found on pages 1714 and 1715 of the Legislative Journal.) 26 ayes, 12 nays on the motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR LABEDZ: The bill is advanced. I believe 490 is the next bill. Senator Vard Johnson is excused so we will go on to LB 494.

CLERK: Madam Chair, 494 offered by Senator Labeledz. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 19th of this year. It was referred to the Revenue Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are Revenue Committee amendments pending.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Carsten on the committee amendments.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I move for the adoption of the committee amendment. The committee amendment only adds the E clause and the purpose for that was that it would then be applicable to this calendar year and in light of the deadlines for filing and so forth, the E clause needed to be added, and it is in that light that we present it to you and I request again that you support the committee amendment to add the E clause.
