

went through what is existing law. We didn't realize that the creative Miscellaneous Subjects Committee would invent a new classification, stick it into the law and pass it before we could get this bill up. So, if you look at the amendment we are simply adding the language about a renewable retail bottle club license, a new provision invented by Senator Hefner and the rest of the creative gentlemen on the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee. There is also another reference on the renewal of such a license and that is contained in LB 213. To harmonize LB 498 with the law changes impending in 213 and has been made in LB 133, we need to adopt this amendment so the Government Committee can keep its bills in perfect running order. I move adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, I rise to support this amendment. I think that it will certainly take care of the problem that we see. So I would urge the body to adopt this amendment, let us study it just a little bit further and then probably we can read it on Final Reading in a couple of days.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Wagner.

SENATOR WAGNER: Mr. Speaker and members, I hate to see a bill amended like this but it does clarify it and I think it will make the bill much better than what it was. So I would move adoption of the amendment. . . support the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Landis, do you wish to close? The question is the return of the bill for a specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 0 nays, on the motion to return the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is returned. Senator Landis. Did you want to move adoption of your amendment, Senator Landis?

SENATOR LANDIS: Move the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.
