SPEAKER NICHOL: We are now voting on the amendments as proposed by these various legislators with DeCamp, Remmers, Sleck, Clark, and so forth. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: They are adopted. Senator DeCamp, did you wish to move the bill?

SENATOR DeCAMP: (Mike off) Yes.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the advancement of LB 343. All those in favor say aye, opposed nay. Let's see, Senator DeCamp, did you wish to speak on that?

SENATOR DeCAMP: I will get to speak on the A bill. I think Senator Beutler wants to say something possibly.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Well, his light is not on but would that be all right to be on the A bill? The bill is advanced. Now we will move to 343A.

CLERK: Mr. President, 343A, I do have an amendment pending by Senator DeCamp.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, I have an amendment up there, and as I promised you on General File, the amendment significantly reduces the impact of the A bill. In fact, the ultimate impact is zero dollars upon the taxpayer and treasury of the state. That was the goal. That is what the amendments accomplish. How do they do that? Because the lending institutions of the state have agreed to finance the implementation of this system and ultimately it is a totally consumer financed system with the filing fees. The A bill does have an initial impact of \$63,750 to the Secretary of State to input the information transmitted from the county clerks into the control data base, in other words the programming, the computer programming, the things you want to tax, anyway, provides \$50,000 to the council, remember we set up a special council for conducting the study and some computer programming costs, and it lapses \$113,750 from the cash fund to reimburse the general fund for the costs incurred, oh yeah, I see, and then it adds the emergency clause to coincide with LB 343 as amended. So it does precisely what I said it
