Howard Peterson, would you record your presence please. Senator Goll, would you record your presence please. Senator Withem. Senator Cullan. Senator Higgins. Senator Withem please. Senator Chambers and Senator Withem. Oh, Senator Withem is excused. Senator Chambers, Senator Hefner. Senator Hefner, please. Senators Chambers and Hefner. We are voting on the advancement of LB 451. Senators Chronister, Chambers, and Hefner. The House is under Call.

CLERK: Senator Warner voting no. Senator Higgins voting yes. Senator Richard Peterson voting yes. Senator Hoagland voting yes. Senator Remmers changing from no to yes. Senator Hannibal voting yes. Senator Lundy voting yes. Senator Sieck voting yes. Senator Rod Johnson voting no. Senator Lamb voting no.

PRESIDENT: Senators Chambers, Hefner, and Chronister, please report to the Chamber. The House is under Call. We are voting on the advancement of LB 451. You may call in your vote. Voting on the advancement of LB 451. Call in votes may be made.

CLERK: Senator Rod Johnson changing from no to yes. Senator Chambers voting no.

PRESIDENT: Senator Chronister, you are still not reporting. Senator Eret.

CLERK: Senator Eret voting yes. Senator Abboud voting yes.

PRESIDENT: The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 10 nays, Mr. President.
