SPEAKER NICHOL PRESIDING

SPEAKER NICHOL: Good Morning. We have with us this morning as our Chaplain, Reverend Alex Wacker, pastor of St. Andrews Lutheran Church in Lincoln, Nebraska. Pastor Wacker.

PASTOR WACKER: Prayer offered.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Thank you, Dr. Wacker. Roll call, please. While you are punching in would you direct your attention to the Clerk's desk, please, and observe. Mr. President, LR 77 is ready for your signature.

SPEAKER NICHOL: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business I propose to sign and do sign LR 77.
