LB 617

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes, we have more amendments to the bill.

SENATOR REMMERS: Okay.

SPEAKER NICHOL: We will probably be back to this Friday, Senator Remmers. Okay, thank you. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a series of motions on 617. The first motion I have is by Senator Chambers. Mr. President, Senator Chambers is excused until he returns. The next motion I have is by Senator Richard Peterson. Senator Richard Peterson would move to return LB 617 to Select File for a specific amendment. Senator Peterson's amendment is on page 1757 of the Journal.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Richard Peterson.

SENATOR R. PETERSON: Mr. President and members, you almost caught me here. I thought we were going to go on. I didn't know we were going to get to 617. What this does, as originally. . . in the bill it was \$25 for a health certificate to sell bees. So if Senator Goodrich has two hives of bees to sell as is originally in the bill, and he gets sale price of \$50 a hive, which is \$100, it is going to cost him \$25 to get a permit to get them inspected. What this does is says that he needs to pay a little fee which would be three dollars a colony which would be six dollars instead of \$25 and the larger operation, the larger ones would be charged \$25 a health certificate fee. So it really won't make that much difference, much in the money that will be generated. It will be a little less but it will still be about the same because there are very few of the small colonies that are being sold. So I ask for adoption of this amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the. . . the motion is to return the bill for a specific. . . .

SENATOR R. PETERSON: Yes, I move to return the bill for a specific amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Please vote if you wish too. We are voting on the return for. . . return of the bill for an amendment by Richard Peterson. Senator Richard Peterson.

SENATOR R. PETERSON: I guess we just as well have a Call of the House and get this over with.
