LB 234, 234A

SENATOR LANDIS: I move the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Haberman, did you wish to speak, your light is on. Okay, the question is the adoption of the Landis amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Landis amendment is adopted. Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: I move the readvancement of LB 234.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You heard the motion. All those in favor say aye, opposed nay. It is advanced. Nothing else on the bill? Something to read in, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, study resolutions. LR 136 by Public Health, calls for a study of community action agencies addressing specific areas of interest; 137 by Senator Fenger calls for a study to examine the current status of bureau examining boards to determine whether the restructuring of the bureau is needed to bring its statutory purpose in conjunction with its operation; 138 by Senator Fenger calls for a study of the expanded role of nursing in obstetrics and gynecology in Nebraska; 139 by Senator... by the Banking Committee would call for a study of the desirability of enacting legislation permitting reciprocity with adjacent states regarding ownership of banks by banking institutions. SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 234A. We have an amendment on 234A.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Wiitala would move to return 234A to Select File for a specific amendment. The amendment is on page 2016 of the Journal.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Wiitala.

SENATOR WIITALA: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, I would move to return LB 234 to Select File for a specific amendment. Largely this is an addition to the A bill based upon the amendments that we adopted the last time, and it just brings it parallel to the fiscal impact of the bill, which by the way is really no fiscal impact to the state because all of the financial impact is paid through by fees. So there shouldn't be any monies I don't believe taken out of the general fund that aren't going to be reimbursed through the fee structure of LB 234.
