SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the Warner amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have all of you that wish to vote voted? Senator Warner, did you wish a Call of the House? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment is adopted. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: I move the bill be readvanced.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion is to advance the bill. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. Before we take up the next amendment, may I introduce some guests in the north balcony. Senator Lamb has 20 Eighth Grade students from the Bassett Grade School at Bassett, Nebraska, and their teacher is Ron Knispel. Would you please stand and be recognized. Thank you. Senator Remmers also has 20 Kindergarten through Eighth Grade students from Julian, Nebraska, District 36, in Otoe County, and their teacher is Janis Grimes. Would you please stand and be recognized. Thank you. Another amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner would move to return the bill. Senator Warner's amendment is on page 2038.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, this language would be the same issue as was involved in 469 that permitted the transfer of certain funds to the general fund, and the reason this would be needed was the amendment that was put on by Senator Landis, some of you recall on 628 some days ago that it transferred fifty thousand from the Nebraska Energy Resource Fund which was the one in the Department of Revenue to the general fund, and this merely puts the statutory authorization, which is what is now required, into the proper section. That section was already in 607. That is why we are using the bill to make the amendment. So I would move that the bill be returned for the adoption of that amendment.
