CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Warner's amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion is adopted. Do you have another motion? Senator Warner, do you want to advance the bill?

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move the bill be re-advanced.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is, shall LB 607 be advanced? All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. LB 618. Oh, there is another amendment? Excuse me.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Carsten would move to return the bill for a specific amendment, the amendment being to strike original Section 2.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, the amendment that was offered by Senator Carsten takes out Section 2 in 607 and that section dealt with changing the pay-out dates in this case only to the school districts. All of those changes are included in the amendment that was adopted on LB 59, including some additional ones. The reason for taking it out of this bill is that then we do not need to worry about which one passes first or last and not make those...have to make those internal adjustments, and then all of these provisions will be in 59, plus other things. There was no need for it to be in both bills. So this takes that change out of this bill and all change will be in one bill that way. So I would move the adoption of Senator Carsten's amendment...or move to have the bill returned for the adoption of Senator Carsten's amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the return of 607 for an amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion is returned. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I would move the adoption of Senator Carsten's amendment.
