Mr. President, Retirement Systems reports 457 to General File; 450 to General File and 321 to General File with committee amendments attached. (See pages 2083 and 2084 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: The reason we are sticking around, of course, is to get in the study resolutions that are being advanced, and in case you haven't realized it you just acted on the last priority bill this year so that is pretty good. I don't remember that ever happening before but that is good. Next Monday we are going to be easy on you, we are going to start at 9:00 instead of 8:30. Next week we hope to have all the appropriation bills and budget bills passed and on their way so that they can be back in plenty of time for any line-item vetoes that you may wish to do. The agendas are out already and have been since before lunch in case you want them before the weekend, and they are quite self-explanatory. We have all of the bills down from the bill drafter's office that we needed and that was part of the reason why we broke for lunch and came back to give them some time to get the bills back today instead of Monday which will mean saving some time next week, especially on appropriation bills. We need to stick around just a few more minutes for these resolutions that are coming in until...so that they can be announced. There won't be any other further voting or business of that nature the rest of the day.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schmit would like to print amendments to 118 in the Journal. (See page 2085 of the Legislative Journal.) Study resolution 175 by Senator Wesely. Purpose is to review severance tax as set forth in LB 216. 176 by Senator Wesely would call for a study of the difference between financing by mortgage and financing by trust deed. 177 by Senator Wesely would call for the wellhead price of natural gas and review of natural gas prices generally. 178 by Senator Wesely of energy conservation and related programs. 179 by Senator Wesely would allow for review of the school fund,
