PRESIDENT MCGINLEY PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: This morning our guest chaplain is Pastor Emeritus at the University Lutheran Chapel, Lincoln. I give you Dr. Al Norden.

DR. AL NORDEN: (Prayer offered.)
