LB 410, 410A, 118A, 617, 630

question has been called. Senator Haberman withdraws your motion. All motions withdrawn. Very well, proceed with reading the bill, Mr. Clerk, LB 410.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 410 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 410 pass on Final Reading? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all had the opportunity to vote? Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 2140 and 2141, Legislative Journal.) The vote is 34 ayes, 13 nays, 1 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority having voted in the affirmative, LB 410 is declared passed on Final Reading. LB 410A.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hoagland had an amendment printed to 410A that I understand he wishes to withdraw.

PRESIDENT: Without objection, so ordered.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 410A on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass on Final Reading? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 2141 and 2142, Legislative Journal.) The vote is 36 ayes, 12 nays, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A sufficient majority having voted in the affirmative, LB 410A is declared passed on Final Reading. Any matters for the record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, yes, I do. Your committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports we have carefully examined and reviewed LB 617 and 630 and find both correctly engrossed, and those are both signed by Senator Rod Johnson.

PRESIDENT: Proceed to General File, LB 118A.

CLERK: Mr. President, 118A (read title).

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner.
