LB 583

CLERK: Mr. President, Legislative Bill 583 was a bill introduced by Senator Richard Peterson and Senator Cullan. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 19 of this year. It was referred to the Public Health Committee. The bill was advanced to General File, Mr. President. I do have the Public Health and Welfare Committee amendments pending.

PRESIDENT: Senator Fenger for the amendments.

SENATOR FENGER: Thank you, Mr. President. Committee amendments merely add the emergency clause and since the bill described the geographic area of 10 miles, the Committee reduced that radius to five. Outside of that, only the words "third-party" were hyphenated. That is the content of the Committee amendments and I would move their adoption.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: (No response).

PRESIDENT: Any other discussion on the amendments? If not, the question is the adoption of the Committee amendments as explained by Senator Fenger. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the Committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: Committee amendments are adopted. Senator Richard Peterson. Or do you have an amendment, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. Senator, I assume you want to take up your amendment now.

SENATOR PETERSON: Yes.

CLERK: All right. Mr. President, first of all, Senator Richard Peterson has an amendment on page 890 he wishes to withdraw. Senator Peterson will now move to amend the bill, Mr. President. The amendment is on page 2097 of the Journal. It would read as follows. (Read amendment.)

PRESIDENT: Senator Richard Peterson.

SENATOR RICHARD PETERSON: Mr. President and members, this amend...you have the amendment before you and this amendment is a simple additional limitation on geographic and population of the area and I ask for its adoption.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the amendment as explained by Senator Richard Peterson. Senator Wesely, please. No,
