PRESIDENT: You heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried, the amendments are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I would move we advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB 253 off Select File. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried.

CLERK: LB 621 is the next one I have, Senator, and there are E & R amendments.
