If not, all those in favor of adopting the Warner amendment, Senator Pirsch, did you have a question?

SENATOR PIRSCH: Question for Senator Warner. Senator Warner, we are striking lines 10-13 and increasing that length to 53 feet, is that correct?

SENATOR WARNER: That is in LB 411. This is 244, this one deals with width.

SENATOR PIRSCH: I'm sorry, I'm way behind. Thank you.

SENATOR WARNER: No, you are way ahead.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on the Warner amendment? If not, all those in favor of the Warner amendment vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please cooperate and record your vote on the Warner amendment, if you wish to be recorded. Take another 20 seconds. Voting on the Warner amendment to LB 244.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I assume I may have to have a Call of the House for the Exec Board.

PRESIDENT: A Call of the House has been requested. All those in favor of Calling the House under Call vote aye, opposed vote no. Clerk will record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 10 ayes, 1 nay to go under Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: By that vote the House is under Call for the purpose of arriving at a vote on a Warner amendment to LB 244. Would all members in the Legislature please check the attendance board and record your presence, those of you that are in the Chamber please check your buttons on the lights in the front of the chamber. ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Schmit voting yes.
