LB 146

CLERK: Senator Beutler would move to amend the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this is a short technical amendment that the Judiciary Committee had which we held till Select File. All it does is clarify one provision. There is a provision that says that a guardian shall not be required...to be appointed to give consent to the adoption of any child born in a foreign country. The intent of the whole bill is that the guardian shall not be required so long as the adoption has fulfilled the requirements of the bill itself. So we are putting in that language, Senator Johnson, that says, "whose adoption has fulfilled the requirements of this section", to make that perfectly clear. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion of the Beutler amendment? If not, the question is the adoption of the Beutler amendment to LB 146. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. We are voting on the Beutler amendment to 146. Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

PRESIDENT: Motion carried, the Beutler amendment is adopted. Further things on the bill?

CLERK: Nothing further.

PRESIDENT: Senator Johnson, are you available? Senator Johnson moves to advance the bill from Select File to E & R for Engrossment. Senator.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I move for the advancement of LB 146.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye, opposed no. The motion carried, the bill is advanced. Okay, is there anything to read into the Journal at this point, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: No, sir.

PRESIDENT: Mr. Speaker, do you wish to proceed? Senator Pirsch.
