SENATOR HOAGLAND: Okay, thank you.

PRESIDENT: We could go to LB 193, Senator Carsten, did you want to do that on nonpriority bill? Anybody want to take up 408, Senator Warner? Well, we're looking for something to do. Is 408 simple enough to we could move ahead with? Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, Mr. President, this shouldn't take but a second. It's LB 338 was advanced without opposition.

PRESIDENT: 408.

SENATOR WESELY: Yeah, we're on 408.

PRESIDENT: We have E&R amendments apparently. Is Senator Johnson available? Senator Wesely, would you move the E&R amendments, please?

SENATOR WESELY: You bet. I'll move them. I move the E&R amendments to 408.
