SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 469 passes with the emergency clause attached. LB 607 with the emergency clause.

CLERK: (Read LB 607 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on page 2249 of the Legislative Journal.) 42 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, 5 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 607 passes with the emergency clause attached. LB 608 with the emergency clause.

CLERK: (Read LB 608 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on page 2250 of the Legislative Journal.) 43 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, 4 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 608 passes with the emergency clause attached. LB 617. Would you like to read something in, Mr. Clerk?
