CLERK: Mr. President, your Enrolling Clerk has presented to the Governor the bills that were on Final Reading thus far this afternoon.

Senator Warner would like to print an amendment to 632.

Appropriations reports 632 advanced to General File with committee amendments attached.

Enrollment and Review reports 17, 253, 388, 494, 621, 210, 224, 356A and 472 all correctly engrossed. All signed by Senator Rod Johnson as Chair.

Senator Hoagland would like to print amendments to 336 in the Journal, Mr. President.

Mr. President, new A bill, Legislative Bill 632A, it is a bill to appropriate funds to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 632.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 617 with the Emergency Clause attached.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Final Reading LB 617.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass. All those in favor vote aye, with the emergency clause attached. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk. Senator Warner.
