LB 336, 17, 228

CLERK: (Roll call vote.) 26 ayes, 22 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to indefinitely postpone. (See pages 2321-22 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: Motion is carried and LB 336 is indefinitely postponed. The Call is raised. The Clerk will read matters into the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I may, new resolutions. (Read LR 200-202 as found on pages 2323-2325 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, I also have amendments to be printed to LB 17. That is signed by a number of the members. (See pages 2322-2323 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: I guess then we are ready to proceed with LB 228 on Select File, a priority bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have E & R amendments to 228 pending.

PRESIDENT: Senator Rod Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I move for the adoption of the E & R amendments.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. All those in favor of adopting the Enrollment and Review amendments say aye, opposed no. The motion carried. The amendments are adopted.
