Mr. President, the next amendment I have is by Senator Beutler. This is Request #1256, Senator.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: What is the number, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: 1256, Senator.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Would you read the amendment, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Senator, this is the "insert the following new sections, section 71. It is a 3....

SENATOR BEUTLER: Nothing on subsection 3?

CLERK: It is a six page amendment, Senator.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Oh, I wish to withdraw that. That was part of the DeCamp amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: They are withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, then the next amendment is by Senator Beutler. This is the one, Senator, Request #1380, (Read Beutler amendment as found on pages 2365-2366 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, one thing that we are doing with this big package of course is combining these three programs as far as administration is concerned but as I understand the three programs it is still intended that they be separate programs and that they be handled separately and that, for example, the agricultural program or agricultural enterprise program is set up as a separate category under the definition of project so that you have rental housing under #1 which includes residential housing, and then under #2, subcategory of projects, you have agricultural enterprises, and then under subcategory #3, you have several subcategories of manufacturing and business type enterprises. Now the way that this is structured, the definition of business enterprise and commercial enterprise is those definitions would, in my opinion, include farms and the provisions of subsection 3 as it deals with farms are in contradiction
