LB 193, 599, 124

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

PRESIDENT: Do we have any further thing on the bill?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Let's see, is it Senator Carsten? Do you wish to move the bill, it's LB 193.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President, I move that LB 193 as amended be advanced.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to advance LB 193 from Select File to Enrollment and Review for review. All those in favor, say aye. Opposed, no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. LB 124.

CLERK: Mr. President, right before I get to that, Senator Schmit and Goodrich have amendments to be printed to LB 599. (See pages 2402-03 in the Journal). Mr. President, I have E&R amendments to LB 124.

PRESIDENT: Senator Johnson.

SENATOR ROD JOHNSON: Mr. President, I move for the adoption of the E&R amendments.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion for the adoption of the E&R amendments. All those in favor, say aye. Opposed, no. Motion carried. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Wesely would move to amend. Senator Wesely's amendment is on page 2222.

SENATOR WESELY: The train is just a rolling today, isn't it? Mr. President, members of the Legislature, on page 2222 is an amendment that I've also had passed out for you on LB 124 and it deals with some amendments brought to me by the Revenue Department and the Energy Office. This is a cleanup bill dealing with the number of energy legislation that has been passed in previous legislation by Senator DeCamp, Senator Fowler, and myself. The handout that I passed out does have a summary, deals with exactly who qualifies for the tax credit that we passed last year. There was some misinterpretation of that and it also deals with a question about the minimum building energy efficiency standards that we have. So they're technical amendments brought to us by the Energy and Revenue Departments, ask that they be adopted.
