PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on the Sieck proposal? You can close, Senator Sieck.

SENATOR SIECK: Yes, Mr. President, members of the body, the total figure on this \$6,815. Now that is very minimal and I feel that it was a compromise on the part of the Civil Patrol. Now I visited with them this morning and they would agree that they wanted the total bite. I said, well, it is almost going to be impossible to get this, and they said, well, can you take a part of it. I said, no, that doesn't work. You either have to ask for it all or we have to put it on another bill. So he said, well, these are the things that we can live with. They had another item of \$880. So I crossed that out. I thought they could get along without that but these three items they really do need and I would encourage you to bring it up to put this amendment on. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. The motion is to return LB 629 to Select File for a specific amendment that has been under discussion. All those in favor of the return vote aye, opposed vote no. The question before the House is the Sieck proposal to return LB 629 to Select File for the specific amendment on Civil Air Patrol that has been under discussion? All those in favor or against that proposal, please make your wishes known by voting. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 2 nays on the motion to return the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion has been returned to Select File. Now, Senator Sieck, you may move. Motion is to adopt the Sieck amendment. Is there discussion? If not, the motion is to adopt the Sieck amendment that has heretofore been explained. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. We are voting on the adoption of the Sieck amendment to LB 629. We are voting on the adoption of the Sieck amendment concerning the Civil Air Patrol to 629. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 2 nays to adopt the amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carried. The amendment is adopted. Senator Sieck. The motion is to advance LB 629 back to Enrollment and Review for engrossment. All those in favor say aye, opposed no.
