PRESIDENT: The Haberman motion is withdrawn. We will proceed with LB 193.

CLERK: (Read LB 193 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? We are voting on LB 193. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 2492 of the Legislative Journal.) 46 ayes, 1 nay, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A sufficient majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed on Final Reading. I would like to announce that there are guests of Senators Fowler and Warner in the North balcony this morning. They are fifteen students from Arnold School here in Lincoln with ten adults accompanied by Jordan Kominsky the teacher. We welcome you to the Legislature. I might explain to the students that we are engaged in Final Reading this morning. That is the final passage of bills and you are likely to hear little debate from the members today because these bills have been heard in committee, debated on the floor and are now being considered for final passage into law. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business I propose to sign and do sign LBs 146, 356, 356A, 408, 447, 118, 118A and 159. Next is LB 239.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 239 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 239 pass. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Voting on LB 239. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Clerk will record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 47 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President. (Vote appears on pages 2494-45 of the Legislative Journal.)
