DeCamp, please report to the Chamber. The House is under Call. Excuse me, Senator DeCamp is excused. Senator Chronister and Rod Johnson. There is...the distinguished senator from Schuyler is present. Rod Johnson...he is coming. A roll call vote has been requested, correct, Senator Pirsch?

SENATOR PIRSCH: Senator DeCamp's jacket is here. I wonder where he is excused to.

CLERK: (Took roll call vote as found on page 2507 of the Legislative Journal.) 21 ayes, 28 ayes, Mr. President, on the override.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. The House Call is raised and may we proceed with another motion, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I may right before that, I have a new resolution by Senator Chambers, LR 218. (Read LR 218 as found on pages 2508-2509 of the Legislative Journal.) That, Mr. President, will be laid over.

PRESIDENT: The resolution will be laid over one day.

CLERK: Mr. President, 219 by Senator Goodrich and Wesely. (Read LR 219 as found on page 2509 of the Legislative Journal.) That, too, will be laid over, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The resolution will be laid over.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next motion I have on 628 is by Senator Vard Johnson.

PRESIDENT: (Gavel.) Senator Vard Johnson.
