LB 490, 531, 626

PRESIDENT: Please read the bill.

CLERK: (Read LB 490 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 490 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on LB 490. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 2526 and 2527, Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 24 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails by not having achieved the proper majority for voting with the emergency clause. Therefore, now the vote is all provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Voting on LB 490. Have you all voted? You have. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 2527, Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 24 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed. May I announce now that there are guests of Senator Remmers under the South balcony. I would like to call your attention to the fact that we are honored to have Mr. Barry Kennedy from Pawnee City here with us. Mr. Kennedy recently completed his term as World President of the JayCees organization and before that he was with the State and National President of the JayCees. Stand and be recognized. We are pleased to have you with us today. LB 531.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 531 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is shall LB 531 pass? All those in favor, vote aye, Opposed, no. We're voting on LB 531. Please record your vote. We're voting on LB 531. Have you all voted? Have you all voted on 531? 531. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read vote. See page 2528 in the Journal). Vote is 44 ayes, 3 nays, 2 present not voting, Mr. President.
