Board of Regents to consider also the normal kinds of disability insurance that we attorneys purchase, for instance, to protect players in the event that they are seriously injured while playing at the University of Nebraska. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on LR 218? Senator Kilgarin. Excuse me, on the amendment to the resolution. Senator Kilgarin, do you wish to speak on Senator Hoagland's amendment? Anyone wish to speak on Senator Hoagland's amendment? Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: All I will say, Mr. Chairman, is that Senator Hoagland's amendment will make it clear that the Board of Regents Committee can consider other types of insurance than just Workmen's Compensation, so I have no objection to it.

PRESIDENT: The motion is the adoption of the Hoagland amendment to LR 218. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the Hoagland amendment to LR 218. Please record your vote. May we have your attention, please. We are voting on the Hoagland amendment to LR 218. Have you all voted on the Hoagland resolution...on the Hoagland amendment? We are voting on the Hoagland amendment. The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the Hoagland amendment to the resolution.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The amendment is adopted. Now we are back to the resolution as amended. Senator Kilgarin, did you wish to speak on the resolution?

SENATOR KILGARIN: Thank you, Mr. President, I just have one question of Senator Chambers. Senator Chambers, you include only the University of Nebraska. We do have state colleges and I guess even tech colleges in this state and I am also concerned about those football players or baseball players. Is there any way we can incorporate them into this resolution?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, Senator Kilgarin, because of the way the issue has been drawn, whatever would be said about the players at UNL would apply to anybody. It is to look at insurance programs and whatever could be said about Workmen's Comp as it relates to those, would relate to any of them, and I don't want to draft the resolution in such a way that the Board of Regents would say they are being asked to deal in an area that is beyond their
