PRESIDENT: Without objection, so ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 222 is ready for your signature.

PRESIDENT: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LR 222. Ready for item #5 on the agenda, resolution 221. General File, LB 49.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 49.

PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit, there are amendments from your committee to this bill, LB 49.
