**SPEAKER NICHOL:** Senator DeCamp, did you wish to talk to the bill?

**SENATOR DECAMP:** Just a question of Senator Johnson, he has struck a note of concern here. As I understand, he has said county judges absolutely have to charge if they marry somebody.

**SENATOR V. JOHNSON:** Right.

**SENATOR DECAMP:** I am afraid to ask this but what is the penalty if they were a friend and they married you and they didn't charge, does that mean...?

**SENATOR V. JOHNSON:** Oh, then you have been living in sin for the last ten years.

**SENATOR DECAMP:** About seven. Hmm.

**SENATOR V. JOHNSON:** I spoke facetiously. I don't think that is the penalty but they are required to charge.

**SPEAKER NICHOL:** Is there any other discussion on the bill? The question is, shall the bill advance? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

**CLERK:** 27 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

**SPEAKER NICHOL:** LB 492 is advanced. LB 333.

**CLERK:** Mr. President, LB 333 was offered by Senator Goodrich. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 17th last year, referred to Education Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. Mr. President, there are committee amendments pending by the Education committee.

**SPEAKER NICHOL:** Is Senator Vickers going to present those.
