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that cost? Tuition cost only?

SENATOR VICKERS: It is not room and board, it is tuition cost only.

SENATOR NEWELL: I don't see any tuition cost....

SENATOR VICKERS: School related costs, Senator.

SENATOR NEWELL: School related costs.

SENATOR VICKERS: Right.

SENATOR NEWELL: And they don't presently do that for Class 1 districts?

SENATOR VICKERS: No, they don't.

SENATOR NEWELL: And why has that historically been the case, or why is that then the case? Why hasn't that equity measure issue arisen before?

SENATOR VICKERS: I can't answer that. I don't know.

SENATOR NEWELL: Has it been a statutory requirement in the past that it be done this way, or has it been a tradition?

SENATOR VICKERS: I think it has been a statutory requirement that it was done that way.

SENATOR NEWELL: How many districts...about how many Class 1 are affected in this way?

SENATOR VICKERS: I think the fiscal note says there are ten, if I recall correctly, a total of thirty students, I believe.

SENATOR NEWELL: A total of thirty-two districts?

SENATOR VICKERS: Thirty students.

SENATOR NEWELL: Thirty students, ten districts?

SENATOR VICKERS: I believe that is correct. That was last
