All those in favor vote aye, against nay. Please vote.

CLERK: Senator Beutler voting yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Is there anybody else who wishes to vote? Mr. Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR BEUTLER: The bill is advanced. Okay, Senator Wagner, are you ready to go back to LB 38?

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 38 offered by Senators Wagner, Wesely, Chronister, Von Minden and Hefner. (Read.) The bill was read on January 6th last year. It was referred to the Appropriations Committee. The bill was advanced to General File, Mr. President. There are committee amendments pending by the Appropriations Committee.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Warner, on the Appropriations Committee amendment.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move adoption of the amendment. I think that only changes the years, right? The bill as originally drafted was for '83-'84 and this was when we put it out of committee last year we knew it would not be passed until this year and we amended it to the current fiscal year, '84-'85.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Is there anyone who wishes to discuss the committee amendments? Seeing no lights, the motion is the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, against nay.

CLERK: Senator Beutler voting yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Please vote. Let's squeeze out a couple more votes here. Please vote. Is there anybody else who wishes to vote? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the committee amendments.
