SENATOR BEUTLER: I just want to make one comment on...to help out Senator Haberman, I hope a little bit. The idea, Senator Haberman, at one point in time was to pick up additional costs all across the state that were county court costs but it was decided that rather than to change the system all over the state that we would continue to leave it exactly the way it is and not pick up additional county court costs as state costs. For that reason we are deleting from the bill that provision that would have done that and because we are deleting that provision the cost of this bill will not be in excess of \$2 million as you have indicated and will certainly not be in excess of \$2 million at the most.

SENATOR CLARK: Is there any additional comment on the amendment to the committee amendments? If not all those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay.
