He could have taken him to court, yes, because now we do have a sexual contact law but it is a misdemeanor, a Class I misdemeanor, up to \$1,000, up to a year in jail. But parents are saying as parents in all of the other states, Senator Chambers said, well now we can look to Nebraska because Nebraska has this wonderful sexual assault law. Every other state has a minor age. I passed out that list of minor age where they differentiated between that minor in whatever they call it. Some call it indecent liberties, some states. Some call it sexual contact as we do. Some call it child molestation which we don't do. In California they do that. In Arizona they do that. In Arkansas it is sexual contact at fourteen; California at fourteen, a lewd and lascivious acts. Annoying or molesting goes up to eighteen in California. Sexual contact in Colorado is placed at eighteen. Then there is another one for sexual contact under fifteen making it tougher. I could go on and on down this list and I will share this with you if you would like to look at it. This is not the sexual penetration laws, no. It is what they call sexual contact, what they call indecent liberties, what they call child molestation. In Nebraska we call it sexual contact and what this law is saying is that fourteen and under we think
