that fairness of justice would dictate. I know that drunk driving is a contemptible thing. I know drunk drivers don't receive sympathy from anybody and I am not trying to get them sympathy. I am not trying to play down the seriousness of drunk driving. I am saying that a principle has been established in the law that evidence must be gathered a certain way, and if it is not, it can't be used. If they search your home or your person without a warrant, they cannot use that. If a warrant is obtained but it is not with probable cause, even with a warrant it is not valid because you can attack the warrant. What the courts have indicated is that under this system contrary to the way systems operate in other places, a citizen not only is presumed to be innocent until proved guilty, but even before evidence can be gathered for the purpose of making the accusation and seeking the conviction, certain principles and procedures must be followed. If you don't think those procedures are necessary where a person is accused of drunk driving, then you will vote against my proposition which means you will vote red. If you think those rights should be extended to a person even one accused of something so reprehensible as drunk driving, then you will vote green. I am asking that you vote green and say that this right be extended to somebody even one accused of drunk driving.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the Chambers amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. It takes 25 and there is one excused, Senator Chambers. The question is, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
