SENATOR FENGER: Mr. Speaker, at this time I have no problem with the Warner amendment to the committee amendments. I would advise you that we will report back to the Bureau of Medical Examining Boards the adjustment, and if there is a need to readdress it, we will readdress this issue on Select File. Thank you, sir.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of Senator Warner's amendment to the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Warner's amendment to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Warner amendment to the amendment is adopted. We will go back to the amendments but may I first introduce some guests in our north balcony of Senator Landis. They are 14 sixth graders from Sacred Heart School in Lincoln, Nebraska, and their teacher is Joni Glushenko. Welcome to the Legislature. Thank you. Senator Fenger, do you want to go back and talk about the committee amendments?

SENATOR FENGER: Mr. Speaker, I would move the adoption of the committee amendments as explained and as amended.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of committee amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Warner, did you wish to speak about the bill?

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, Senator Fenger indicated there is a whole series of adjustments that affects the Bureau of Examining Boards, the process as well as the reinstating of the Board of Examiners for Psychologists and I think to my knowledge none of the provisions...at least all the provisions are acceptable but I can briefly highlight some of the more
