SENATOR KAHLE: Senator Beutler, do you have anything more to add? We are voting on LB 507. All those in favor say aye. Those opposed say no. Let's try that again. All those in favor say aye. That's better. Those opposed say no. The bill is moved. Mr. Clerk, do you have anything to read in?

CLERK: Mr. President, first of all I have a reference report referring LB 971-1013 as well as referring all gubernatorial appointments received during the interim.
